Thank you for your letter of August 18 regarding the Arkansas Scholarship Lottery and the ADA. We were most happy to hear from the Center and to read the reiteration of the State of Arkansas's responsibilities under ADA.

We are preparing our permanent headquarters at Union Plaza in Little Rock, which will be fully ADA compliant, as will our Claims Centers with leases under preparation in Springdale and Jonesboro. We will be choosing a site in the Camden/El Dorado/Warren area by the end of the week, and are committed to compliance in that Claims Center, as well. Any retrofitting to assure accessibility will be put in place.

The website address for businesses with whom you are working to assure compliance will be most helpful, and we were very pleased to receive it. It is in the interest of all Arkansas citizens, including our players and our scholarship recipients, that ADA be respected and followed. We are committed to the principles you champion in your letter, and we look forward to communicating with you as the process goes forward.
