IF YOUR CHILD IS 3-5, YOU MAY CONTACT YOUR NEAREST ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO GET THE NUMBER OF THE EDUCATIONAL COOPERATIVE IN YOUR AREA THAT COORDINATES THESE SERVICES.

IF YOUR CHILD QUALIFIES FOR SERVICES UNDER THE INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES EDUCATION ACT (IDEA) YOU HAVE A RIGHT TO:

- ◆ **An Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP) (Birth-2)**
- ◆ **An Individualized Education Program (IEP) (3-5)**
- ◆ **Training on disabilities or other subjects**
- ◆ **Transportation to services**
- ◆ **Transition to public school**
- ◆ **A Centralized Directory of resources and services**
- ◆ **Parent involvement**
